

Mazen Najjar, MD

Dr. Mazen Najjar is a graduate from the University of Aleppo. He is an infectious disease specialist and a Clinical Assistant Professor at Michigan State University.

Muhammet Ceren, MD

Dr. Ceren completed his pediatric training in 2006. Since 2019, he has served as the Head of the Migrant Health Center's Health Workers Association. He is also serving as an expert on the COVID Resolution Desk for the Ministry of Health in Turkey. He is married with one child.

Vinod Varma, MD

Dr Vinod Varma is an experienced health systems specialist focusing on primary health care service delivery in fragile and conflict-affected settings and health policy, finance and systems in low and middle-income countries including evaluation of complex interventions, provider payment systems and getting research into practice.

Amjad Bahnassi, MD

Dr. Bahnassi came to Worcester in the early 1980s for a residency program at UMass Medical Center as a psychiatrist and never left. After completing his residency, he started Behavioral Healthcare Services, a practice he still leads after more than 25 years.



Mazen Kewara, MD

Dr. Mazen Kewara is the Turkey Country Director of the Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS), one of the leading medical and humanitarian organizations working in Syria. Dr. Kewara has a medical degree and PhD in vascular surgery from the University of Damascus and has worked in the Tishreen Hospital in Damascus. In 2011 when the conflict in Syria began, Dr. Kewara started treating victims of the government's violence against peaceful protests, but had to leave Syria to Turkey with his family in 2012. Dr. Kewara then started working with SAMS, and was the founding staff member of the SAMS Turkey office. As Country Director, Dr. Kewara has overseen the growth and expansion of SAMS's northern Syria programs, including supporting health workers, sponsoring hospitals, providing cross-border medical assistance, and training hundreds of doctors and nurses. In addition to humanitarian services Dr. Kewara is involved in the documentation of human rights violations that SAMS does to highlight what health workers have been witnessing in Syria. Dr. Kewara participated in the civil society supporting rooms in Geneva talks, and in many other delegations advocating for humanitarian aspects in Syria. He led the organization in Turkey for more involvement and a leading role in humanitarian coordination and civil society activism.

Ghassan Saed. MD

Dr. Ghassan M. Saed is currently a Professor of Gynecologic Oncology in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Wayne State University School of Medicine in Detroit, Michigan. He is an internationally renowned clinical and translational investigator, who is recognized for many scientific contributions within the fields of Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility, Immunology, and Gynecologic Oncology. His contributions include publication of over 300 peer reviewed manuscripts, 10 chapters, and 500 abstracts. Additionally, he has given over 350 scientific presentations.

Khaled Abdullah Alhajji, MD

Dr. Khaled Abdullah Alhajji is originally from Hama, Syria. He is a Cardiologist and has been the medical supervisor for SAMS intensive care projects for the past six years.



Ahmad Maarouf, MD

"Dr. Ahmad Maarouf received his medical degree from Damascus University College of Medicine in Damascus, Syria. He completed residency in Internal Medicine at Western Reserve Care System/Forum Health. He continued his education at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center (UPMC) as a visiting scholar conducting basic science research and won the American Heart Association Physician-Scientist grants to study Epithelial Sodium Channels. Dr. Maarouf completed a nephrology fellowship in 2009 and a critical care fellowship in 2011, both at UPMC. He advanced his education by receiving a master's degree in business administration from Case Western Reserve University in 2018. From 2009 – 2010, he served as a faculty member at Henry Ford Hospital's Nephrology and Hypertension Division. He held numerous medical directorships, committee chairmanships, and staff positions at Beaumont Health, Michigan's largest health system. He also served as a clinical assistant professor at Michigan State University from 2016 until present, and also as the associate program director for the Internal Medicine Residency Program at Beaumont Health – Trenton. While in Michigan, he served as an advisory board member for Life Gift. Dr. Maarouf is a father of two girls and a boy and enjoys traveling and hiking. He enjoys practicing in community hospitals and focusing on the quality of care delivered to the community we serve. Starting March 2021, Dr. Maarouf became the Chief Medical Officer at HCA Houston Healthcare Northwest with primary focus on advancing quality and patient safetv.

Muhammad Abdulgany Hamadeh, MD

Dr. Abdulgany Hamadeh graduated from Damascus University Medical School in 1983. He went on to complete his Internal Medicine residency at the Hines VA/Loyola University Medical Center. He then complete his pulmonary and critical care/sleep fellowship at Northwestern University Medical Center in 1992. He currently practices at Advocate Christ Medical Center and is the Chief of the pulmonary section and Medical Director of the sleep disorder center.



Abd Arrahman Alomar, MD

Dr. Abd Arrahman Alomar is a Syrian Pediatrician, previously working as the Turkey Health Cluster co-coordinator. He is the Senior Health Advisor at SAMS Turkey office.

Abdulghani Sankari, MD

Dr. Abdulghani Sankari, MD, Ph.D., FAASM, FCCP, is a Physician–Scientist, Professor and Director of Medical Education/DIO. Dr. Sankari is Board Certified in Internal Medicine, Pulmonary Diseases, Critical Care Medicine, and Sleep Medicine. He is a member of several Veterans Affairs and National Institutes of Health review panels. Dr. Sankari has secured several million dollars in grants and has been the principal investigator for government– and non–government–funded studies examining pathophysiology and outcomes for sleep–disordered breathing.

Mohammed Morshed Tamim, MD, FAAP

Dr. Tamim graduated from Damascus University Medical School in 1986. He went on to finish his Pediatric Residency and Neonatology Fellowship at Case Medical School, MetroHealth Medical Center in 2006. Before moving to the USA, he finished pediatric residency training and worked for a few years in Dubai, UAE. He has mixed experience between the USA and the Gulf area, Dr. Tamim has also participated in many international conferences in the Gulf Area and in Syria, in addition to other conferences and meetings in the USA. He has published several peer review articles and abstracts in the USA and the UAE. Currently, Dr. Tamim works as an attending neonatology staff member at Akron Children's Hospital, and is Chairman of the Pediatric Educational Committee and Clinical Assistant Professor of Pediatrics.


